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Comments: The Malheur, Umatilla, and Wallowa-Whitman National Forests are critical habitat for some of Oregon's most beloved wildlife, including salmon, trout, deer, and elk, among many others. The USFS should take the utmost care not to degrade this invaluable resource by constructing new roads and opening new logging claims on some of the healthiest surviving wilderness in this state. New road construction warms rivers and streams and causes irreversible damage to riparian habitats. I urge the USFS to maintain strong enforceable standards for water and habitat quality and restrict the building of new roads in the new forest management plan
