Cibola National Forest personnel: I am writing this e-mail to express my opinion on the "Cibola National Forest Wilderness Inventory" initiative being proposed by the Cibola National Forest (CNF). I understand the initiative documents areas within the CNF eligible for wilderness designation, and the initiative is out for public comment at this time. My comments are as follow.

- 1. Sandia Ranger District. In general, I support the wilderness designation for most of the identified eligible areas. However, I question three areas. D5\_ADJ6 (west side Sandias) and D5\_ADJ4 & D5\_ADJ5 (east side Sandias) are heavily used by mountain bike riders (including myself). I would like to see continued use by mountain bikes in these areas, and would oppose any wilderness designation that restricts/prohibits bicycle use in these areas.
- 2. Mountainair Ranger District. I support the wilderness designation for all of the identified eligible areas.
- 3. Mount Taylor Ranger District. I support the wilderness designation for all of the identified eligible areas.
- 4. Magdalena Ranger District. I support the wilderness designation for all of the identified eligible areas. I especially would like to see wilderness designation of the area north of the Magdalena Research Area in the Magdalena Mountains (D3\_5K1, D3\_5K2, & D3\_5K3). I have noticed that this area is being overrun with ORV traffic in recent years. This significantly degrades the experience of non-motorized use in this area.
