DEAR USFS:

I write to object to the Mountain Valley and Atlantic Coast pipelines.

I am concerned because:

- 1) The draft Env. Impact St. for the MVP/ACP did not include mandatory info, was prematurely issued by FERC, diminishing my right to object, in violation of the Nat. Envir. Policy Act.
- 2) Changes to amendments in the Forest Plan for MVP/ACP differ from earlier, is missing in FEIS, depriving we public of opport. to comment.
- 3) There is no sufficient cumulative analysis.
- 4) US Fish & Wildlife did not come to a conclusion yet on safety + effect on habitats.
- 5) MVP/ACP have not answered questions re High Hazard Areas, route variations, construction areas on route, etc.
- 6) The pipelines endanger our water systems.
- 7) The pipelines encourage the use of fuels to the detriment of our local air quality.
