I object to the plan 36 CFR 218 as currently written:

The plan does not do enough to control OSV riding near cabins and near homes, in particular cross country/meadow riding in and around cabin homes.

The map shows the area around the Bennett Juniper (5N01) open to OSVs. This area should not be open to OSVs.

The Near Natural areas Eagle Meadows, Long Valley and the Red Rock Meadow areas are open to cross country OSV use, but should be better protected. Not open to motorized use.
