As a citizen, nature lover and rock climber, I wanted to urge you to reconsider your plans to remove rock climbing bolts from the Tonto National Forest. Rock climbing is an appropriate recreational activity on Forest Service lands. I understand concerns that bolts make changes to the environment, but they are very minimal and in the long term, rock climbers can help provide the public support to keep Tonto and other National Forests and Parks protected and sustainable.
