Comments: My family has been coming to Holland since the late 50's. In that time, the constant has been the peace of the surroundings. There have been changes, most for the better, ie, better managed campgrounds, better maintained roads, but the essence and view from the water have remained unchanged. We are leaseholders on the lake. The Forest Service over the years have requirements that cabins not be visible from the water. With a few exceptions, this has been honored.
