Comments: Thanks for allowing the opportunity for the local citizens comments. I believe you summed up the issues at Cache Creek Trailhead well and are proposing a reasonable plan of action to mitigate or end.

You do OMIT the issue of vehicles SPEEDING on the paved surface of Cache Creek Dr and the gravel road to the trailhead. You can see by my address I live on Cache Creek Dr. Posted speed limit is 15mph. I can say with confidence 80-85% of traffic passing in front of our property are in the 25-35mph range... all day, everyday.

Concerns:

- Safety of wildlife, pedestrians, bikers, horse drawn wagons & other motorized vehicles.
- Winter's snow covered roads do not change the speed.
- Wildlife in winter. As you can see from the attached photos, our moose population travels the road. Residents are harassed when we try to ask motorists to yield to the moose on the roadway. Be patient and let the moose pass by your vehicle.

Action: Cache Creek residents have asked the the city & law enforcement to place a 3-way stop at the Cache Creek Dr & Lodge Pole Ln intersection. Response: Need to do a study. Note: A similar speed control tactic was used at the intersection of E Pearl & Rancher with success in lowering the speed.

PLEASE include a 3 Way STOP sign in you plan.

As I stated before, your report has identified the multiple issues at Cache Creek. Please allow me to reemphasize two more: (1) the Winter Wildlife closure area being ignored and (2) the dumping of town snow from private contractors on the creek's watershed. That open field adjacent to the start of the gravel road.
