Comments: Forest Dumpsters Next to Wild & Scenic River

Locating Forest dumpsters directly above a designated Wild and Scenic River is a violation of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act. The dumpsters are often over-flowing and the trash is then washed into the Rio Mayames. Local people also deposit their trash here causing further overflow problems. The Wild and Scenic Rivers Act charges The Forest Service to protect designated river and their immediate environments "for the benefit and enjoyment of present and future generations." Allowing trash to flow into the river does not accomplish this portion of the Act. Please relocate these dumpsters to an ecologically responsible location.
